DID YOU KNOW?

- > 329 People have been exonerated through DNA evidence since 1989
 - o Exonerations are from 38 states and the District of Columbia
 - o 20 people served time on death row
- ➤ Average length of time served is 13.5 years
 - o Total number of years served is over 4,337
- Over 1,600 exonerations nationwide overall since 1989

HOW CAN THIS HAPPEN?

- Eyewitness Misidentification Testimony was a factor in nearly 72% of exonerations and 80% of wrongful sexual assault convictions.
- <u>Unvalidated or Improper Forensic Science</u> played a role in approximately 50% of the cases.
- False confessions and incriminating statements lead to wrongful convictions in approximately 25% of cases.
- ➤ <u>Informants and incentivized witnesses</u> providing false testimony contributed to wrongful convictions in 19% of cases.

COULD THIS AFFECT ME?

- True perpetrators have been identified in 148 DNA cases (45%)
- Additional crimes committed include 70 sex assaults, 32 murders

HOW CAN WE PREVENT IT?

- > Using best practices in eyewitness identification procedures
- Recording suspect custodial interrogations
- > Forensic science accreditation and oversight
- Regulating informant testimony
