- The Pennsylvania Innocence Project is a Pennsylvania non-profit corporation organized to exonerate those convicted of crimes ***they did not commit.***
- With a three-person legal staff and one investigator, the Project works with volunteer law students and attorneys to identify, investigate, and litigate claims of innocence from Pennsylvania inmates.

OUR CASES

- In 2013, our clients **Lance Felder** and **Eugene Gilyard** were released after serving 15 years each for a murder neither man committed. This past year, both **Greg Brown** and **Letitia Smallwood** won new trials and the chance to prove their innocence after serving 17 and 42 years in prison, respectively, for a situation where no crime was committed.
- After years of case development, the Project has 21 cases in litigation throughout the Commonwealth, and we are actively investigating several more. We have identified two true perpetrators.
- Combined, these clients have so far served **415** years in prison.

HELP FREE THE INNOCENT

- As a small office covering a very large state, we rely upon volunteer lawyers to help evaluate, investigate, and litigate all our cases.
- Lawyers can choose to do a full case evaluation with a team at their own firm. These evaluations are critical to identifying the convicted innocent. Training is provided by the Project at the lawyers' firms, and all the work is done at the firms.
- When lawyers identify a case of innocence, they may continue working for that individual by investigating the case, preparing motions for court, litigating the petitions in court, and any other act needed to exonerate that individual. **To set up a training at your firm, contact us at 215-204-4255.**
